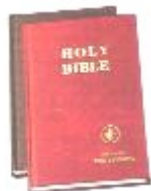
Women of the Bible

These arrangements were approved by last Sunday's congregational meeting.

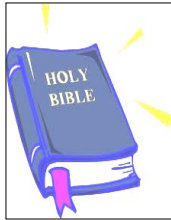
The Gloucester Church is to provide accommodation for Keith for three nights per week via either billets or motel accommodation.
